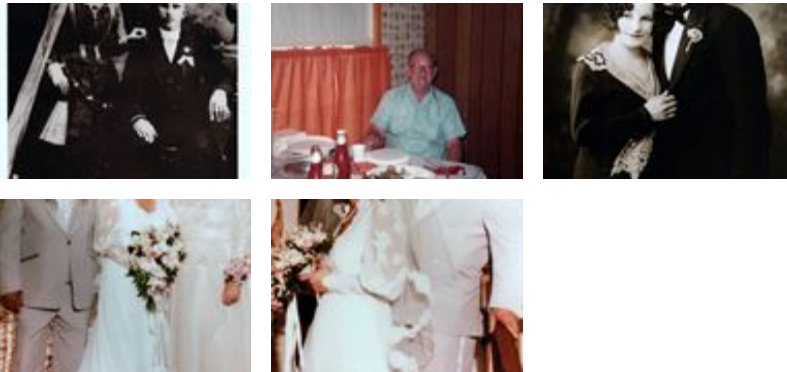


“ *To my wonderful mother,
