Betty and Ted had a beautiful marriage and constantly supported each other. She often said that Ted was a wonderful husband, and she was so fortunate to have found such a kind and patient man. She appreciated him so much and was thankful for their marriage.

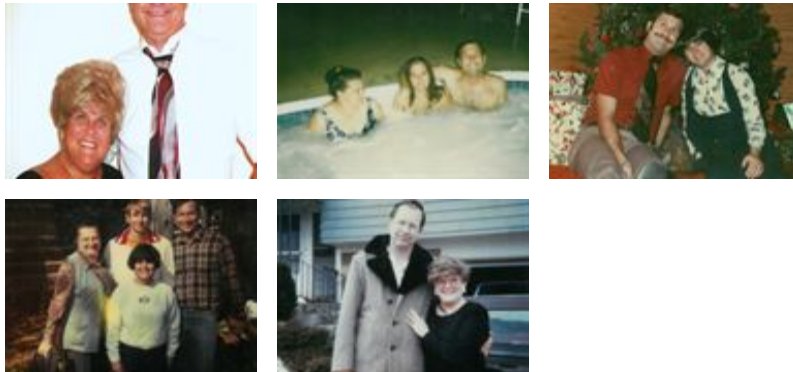
