C. Wayne Goede, of Sun City, Ariz. formerly of South Barrington, Illinois.

Well known originator of one of the entertainment pumpkin farm concepts started in the early 1960's at Planeview Pumpkin Farm in South Barrington, passed away at his permanent home in Sun City, at the age of 75.
