Most proudly, in 2006 he was inducted to the Illinois Hockey Hall of Fame

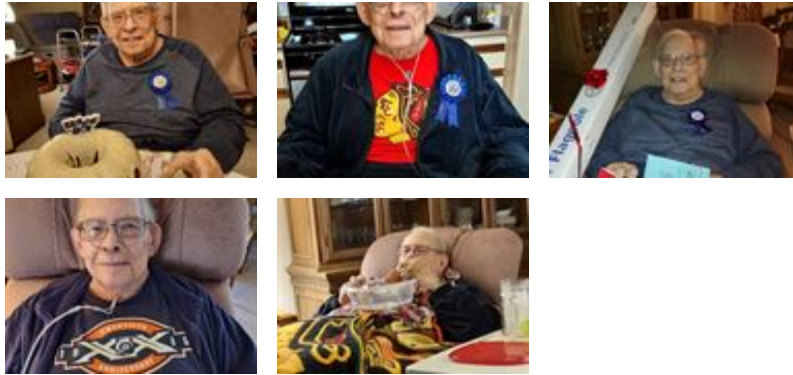
