Charles Addison Crumlett - (April 4, 1998 - March 15, 2024) - was born the day after the Chicago Cubs season opener in 1998, and his middle name is a Cubs reference. He was named Charles, after his uncle Chuck.

Charlie graduated from Streamwood High School as a 12 sport athlete in 2016. In elementary and middle school, he played baseball in Streamwood Little League, and he was active with the Boy Scouts, because his friend's family was active and invited him to join them. He ran cross country, wrestled, and ran track, but wrestling was always his favorite sport. That was the season we all looked forward to, because he was so fun to watch.

From a very early age, dinosaurs were his favorite. In his quirky way, Charlie used to call his mom "The Mother of Dinosaurs." He loved getting into all sorts of trouble with his friends and brothers and sister.

Charles Addison Crumlett was always making things—often out of odds and ends. When he was young he used legos, and he made things out of duct tape. His mom once found a little book in his room that he made out of paper, bound together, and titled, "Charlie's Secret War Plans." When he was older he loved making knives with his dad and working on his truck—and he still

made things out of duct tape. He loved his job for the same reason, it involved working on things and fixing things. He was also very close with the guys he worked with. It was clear they were family for each other.

Charlie joined the Air Force after high school in 2016, completed his 6 years, and extended for another 4 years. He served at Seymour Johnson AFB in North Carolina, working on the F-15 Strike Eagle, Osan Air Base in Korea, working on the A-10 Thunderbolt II, and Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson (JBER) in Alaska, working on the F-22 Raptor. His parents hugged and kissed him goodbye in Goldsboro, NC on April 3, 2019, and he spent his 21st birthday traveling to Jordan for his first deployment.

Loving son of Michael and Tami Crumlett; devoted brother of Collin (Alison) Crumlett, Shannon Crumlett, Joseph Crumlett and Bob Crumlett; cherished uncle of Amelia; beloved grandson of Mary and the late Bob Crumlett.

“ I’ll always remember Charles as being the goofiest guy in our little group of neighborhood boys. Me, Jackie, Erik and Charles would hang out often and our brothers would often try to hang out with us too, but we were the core 4.

All 4 of us would ride our bikes, racing each other. Sword fight with toys or if need be sticks. Play with Pokémon and Yu-Gi-Oh cards, show off Lego sets, etc.

One memory I will always remember about Charles; at the park by the pond one day, and this was just how goofy Charles was, he was making out with one of the park poles, and he invited all of us to try it too! I don’t remember who followed in his footsteps, or if we all said something along the lines of “heck no.” But it was just so funny to me, and I will always remember that memory. I could probably point out the spot to you at that park if I were to go back there. I have not stayed in touch with the other guys since our middle school days. But hearing of Charles passing still is a shock and upsetting.

Me and my small group of guys have prayed for Charles family, and everyone affected by his death.

But I am sure everyone has a goofy memory like mine of Charles, and can hold onto that, and know he brought that joy with him wherever he went!
