Diane Betty Lipari, 83, passed away peacefully on May 18, 2026. Born on September 10, 1942, to James and Bernice Berg, Diane lived a life defined by her deep love for family, her fierce strength, and an infectious joy that touched everyone around her.

Christmas without all the cavatelli and braciolo at the table. Even after she moved to Florida, that spirit of gathering never left her, always being ready for an event or night out to dinner with friends.

Diane had a wonderful zest for life that took her far beyond her front door. She loved to travel, and one of her most treasured adventures was a fabulous trip to Italy to celebrate her birthday, surrounded by Joe and many dear friends — a memory her family will always hold close. Closer to home, she adored the magic of live theater, and seeing Jersey Boys with Joe in New York City was among her most cherished experiences.

Those who knew Diane knew a few things for certain: there was always a Pepsi nearby — a lifelong passion she held faithfully until her very last days — and there was likely a card game in progress. Her weekly card games were a staple of her life, and she brought that same enthusiasm to bunco, her Nintendo DS and Wii. A bingo game or trip to the casino rounded out that gambling spirit in her. She was an avid reader with a book always within reach, and her hands were rarely idle — she crocheted blankets for family and friends, wrapping the people she loved in something handmade and warm.

Diane is survived by her three children: son Joseph Lipari (Pam), daughter Tracy Lipari, and daughter Melissa Lipari; her four beloved grandchildren Emily, Milana, JP, and Mia; her sisters Gloria Beck (the late Tim Beck) and Eileen Strzalka (Gary); and her cherished nieces and nephews Brian Beck, Jim Beck (Christie), Jeff Strzalka (Lisa), Jodi (Ryan), and Greg (Sarah).

She was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Lipari; her parents, James and Bernice Berg; and her brother-in-laws, William Lipari and Tim Beck.
