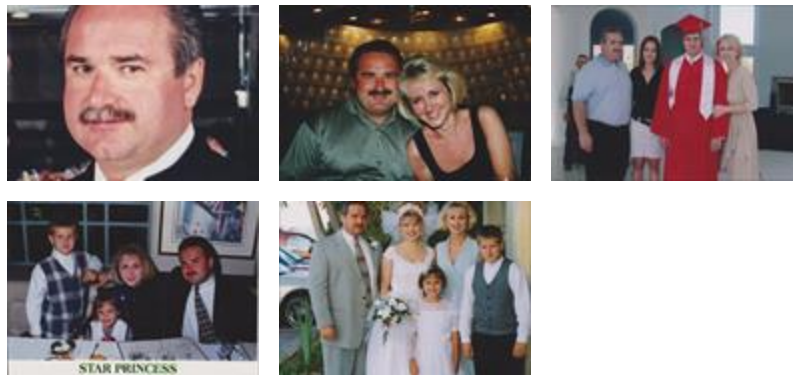


“ *Dear Zorica,
