Glen passed away peacefully on June 20, 2020, at age 95. Born and raised in Chicago, he graduated from Lane Tech High School and entered the US Navy during WWII. He was awarded the WWII Victory Medal, American Theater Ribbon, European-African Middle Eastern Theater ribbon and 2 Bronze Battle stars, 3 Overseas Service Bars and the Good Conduct Medal. After his military service he earned his education degree from DePaul University. Glen married Ruth Newman in 1955, and they were happily married for 46 years. He lived a life dedicated to learning and was a Chicago Public School teacher, who taught English as a Second Language and woodshop. He earned a Masters of Science in Education, from Chicago State University. He loved traveling , volunteer work, and talking with others.
