JulieAnn Villa, age 48, of Chicago, Illinois. JulieAnn died Saturday May 27, 2023 in hospice surrounded by family, friends, amazing images of the life she lead and, of course, the best Spotify playlists ever assembled.

Loving daughter of Geraldine “Jeri” Villa and Robert “Bob” (Sue) Villa; devoted sister of Robert (Kathleen) Villa and Kristin Villa; cherished aunt of Robert and Kayla.

JulieAnn’s life was a life lived forward. Always forward. It was never easy. It was, nevertheless, always forward.

After graduating from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) with a degree in Chemistry she became an educator. A profession she committed her life too. She taught youth in Boston; Buenos Aries, Argentina; Guadalajara, Mexico; and in Illinois at Lane Technical College Prep (2002-2008) and Niles West High School (2008-2018). Her own education continued with numerous summer research projects through Northwestern University’s Research Experience for Teachers programs (2001-2017) and Master’s degrees in Education from DePaul University and most recently, in Health Communication from Northwestern University.

In her personal life, JulieAnn was an accomplished cyclist, marathoner, Michelin star foodie, and costume-clad inspirational force who motivated countless others to achieve what they believed they could not. To help people move emotionally and physically forward past what life threw at them. And she did it the way the best educators do - she made sure it was fun. She ran races and cycled crazy miles adorned in flowers, her favorite color purple, as a credible unicorn, rainbowed to support others, cheetah patterned for her crew, Dia de los Muertos faced, and wearing crazy headbands while powering through it. And, of course, she did all of it “owning every mile with grace, courage and gratitude. - JA”
