“ I knew Kirk from St. Margaret’s where he and my brother Terry were good buddies. They were a few grades behind me in school. My older brother Joe was in class with Mark. I spent a lot of time watching my brothers play sports and got to know their friends. While Joe and Mark’s teams were above average in size, Terry and Kirk’s team lived up to the Pee Wee League label. The majority of them were unusually short for their age, but what they lacked in height, they made up in talent. Kirk’s natural athleticism was taken for granted because all those guys were very good. They were so much fun to watch whether it was football, basketball, baseball, or just playing, skating, and swimming in our backyard. I didn’t like *The Boxing Show*, those were hard to watch, but the boys didn’t let it get in the way of their friendships. When I got my drivers license, I became a personal chauffeur for Terry and his friends. When they started playing football at OHalleran Park, I picked and dropped off Kirk at his house on Winston, otherwise those guys would have to take the CTA in their green football uniforms. All the boys moved and went to different high schools, but they all continued to keep tabs on each other. In 2015 St. Margaret’s had it’s 140th Reunion and we started working on it a year ahead. I had a list of people to call and Kirk was on the list. I knew from Terry that Kirk had health problems. I was supposed to call to recruit volunteers but he didn’t think he would be able to come to the reunion. I felt bad that his health was so poor, and called him a couple more times to see how he was doing. He seemed to be feeling better and we laughed as we recalled so many antics they pulled over the years. He and Tim ended up coming to the reunion and because I was working it, I didn’t get to spend a lot of time with people but I was so glad to see him and got to talk a bit. He told me how cool he and his friends felt driving around in my pink Cadillac and asked if he ever told me how much he appreciated all the rides I had given him. I told him that I remembered that he always said thank you, and he seemed so relieved. I said Kirk, you were always a really nice kid, really! He just laughed. That’s the last time I saw him; my last memory of Kirk. Nicole & Diana, Megan, Breana, Kalia, Neal, Tim, Mark, Kathy and Jean I am so sorry for your loss. You have lost your Dad, Father-in-

Law, Grandpa, and brother. You are most likely relieved that his suffering is over.

I have lost another person who would be able to transport me to a simpler time where I am not so grown up that I don't yet feel the heaviness of living to miss the ability to still be able to see them as the child they once were.
