*One last story... We were Deep Sea Fishing with Marty I believe it was Britt's wedding in Hawaii and at the end of the expedition, we had a pretty big fish on the line and had hundreds of feet of line down deep into the ocean water. There were 5 or 6 people on the boat - a few guys in their 50s and most of us in our 20s or 30s. We each took turns cranking the reel to pull this fish up to the boat. After 3, 4, 5, 6 times around...everyone's fingers, wrists, forearms, biceps, shoulders were so fatigued and stiff that we all became pretty much useless in cranking up this fish. Suddenly it started to appear as if the fish was going to win this battle over our group. Either that or it would become a Marathon fight. Marty quickly picked up on the group level of exhaustion tell and he straps into the chair when it was his turn and never got out of the seat for about 10 minutes and pulls the fish up to the boat as if it were a Blue Gill. Britt's husband and brother in law were just laughing in disbelief at how strong this old man was...who happened to be about 25 years older and about half their size. But I wasn't surprised - he could've cranked for another 10 minutes easy. I've witnessed Marty hold an Air Hammer to blast concrete at chest level and above his head to demolish 50 year concrete for 30 minutes at a time....on maybe a half dozen occasions. Crazy strength, Ape strength, Old Man strength...whatever you want to call it for most of his life just incredible.*

*We lost a great man this week in Marty and it was an honor and a privilege to be able to call him a friend. Huge loss and we all feel it. Incredible guy. God Bless the entire Brotschul family - prayers are up for a speedy healing process to everyone including family and friends...a process that starts today. These were all great times and you'll have more great times ahead.*
