Loving daughter of Zewditu Nega Biru and the late Mulugeta Mengistu;
devoted sister of Addisu Mengistu.

"Meaza was not only a sister to me; she was everything. She paid my tuition and lodgings when I was a student, covered my medical expenses, sponsored me when I moved to the US, and sent me to a school in India. She would say, 'Pay it forward' whenever I tried to reimburse her. Her generosity knew no bounds. I remember the day of one bitterly cold winter when she took me to a clinic for a checkup. She thought I was not warm enough and offered me her jacket to put on top of the hoodie I was wearing. Meaza was the kind of person who thought of others more than herself. Always helped relatives in need and contributed money to fundraising events and charity. Even when her health was deteriorating she was always concerned about the wellness of our mother and myself. In her last days, she was a survivor of a stroke and bound to a wheelchair. Even when her chance of walking again was slim, she never gave up hope of walking again."

"Dr. Meaza The jewel of our family was born on the 29th of June, 1969. Right from that day until her passing day on a dreaded Monday on the 14th of

October, 2024. She never seized being strength, comfort and inspiration to anybody she touched or contacted. Growing up in Ethiopia, in the comfort of her parents and other family members, had been a focus of the community. She went to the only medical school of the time in Ethiopia and was, sailing up when her father, the late Dr. Mulugeta Mengistu was invited to Walter Reed Memorial Hospital in Washington D.C to do some research. Some weeks before her graduation, Dr. Mulugeta had finalized his research and was about to fly back to Ethiopia. Before his departure, he wanted to pay a short visit to other family members in Columbus, Ohio. Unfortunately, he was struck with a heart attack on one dreaded evening and passed away a couple of weeks later while in the hospital. His contacts in Washington, DC offered to help his kids and wife to come and see him. His answer was typical Dr. Mulugeta. He said "My Daughter is graduating soon and has to serve the people she saw while growing up and being trained". He hoped they helped her come to the USA after serving some years in Ethiopia. I asked him about the merit of his decisions. He told me that he wanted Meaza to treat and see the medical aspects of her people in person, not on paper. Anybody can see where that honest and loving heart of Meaza came from. Sacrifice, Sacrifice his and her immediate benefit to the benefits of others. Not taking of advantage at every opportunity. Pure MEAZA. Dr. Mulugeta died here and his body was sent to his beloved country. Dr. Meaza, served her people in Addis Ababa for some years and came to the USA. She took the foreign graduated Doctors testing that is required and passed it successfully. She started residency in Chicago and worked in and around there until her time. She lived with her mother and brother under one roof. When Meaza meets anybody, the first thing she sees is the person is another human being. Not his color, creed, or status. Just humanity. Anybody with a human brain can see it. She was the epitome of what a human being should look and act if we need a loving earth. I hope I'm not naive. Now Meaza is gone, I'm sure her wish is to keep being at the service of humanity, even after her death. Her mother, Sister Zewditu, a certified nurse and her brother Addisu and other extended family members

are grateful for all the help and encouragement you showed us all. We will never thank you enough for all the time of her sickness for your well wishes, visits and encouragements. Thank You All Very much God bless you All."

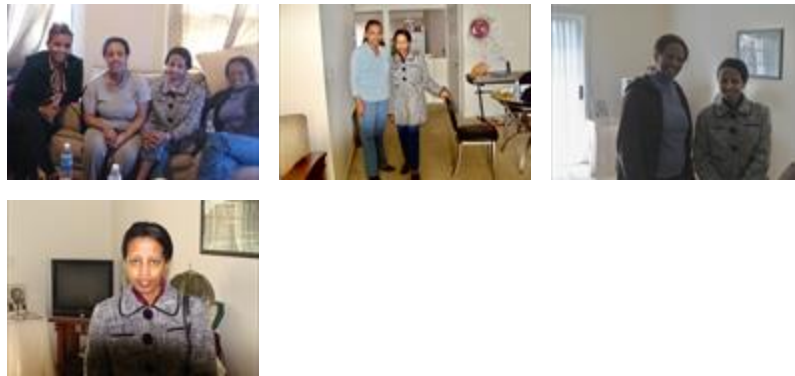

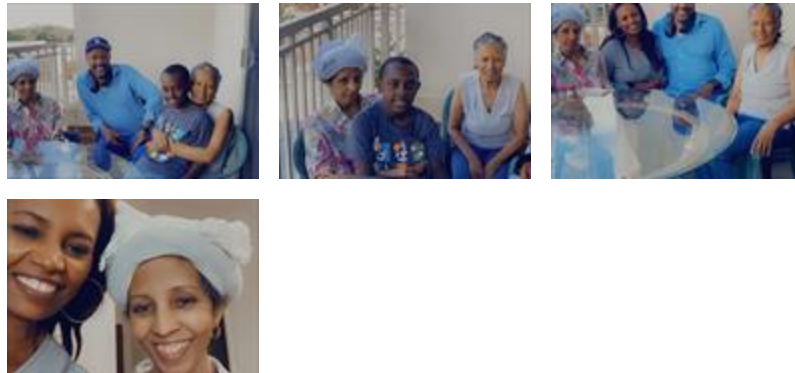
