Michael L. Radick, age 68, a many year resident of Bloomingdale IL., passed away on September 05, 2015, at St. Alexius Medical Center in Hoffman Estates, IL..

Beloved husband of Arlyn Hale, nee Cleveringa; loving father of Leigh Ann (Jerry) Buck and John Reed; cherished grandfather of Ashleigh Murray and Zac Buck; great grandfather of Karleigh and Kaison Murray.

Born in Flint, Michigan, Michael grew up in Whitefish Bay, Wisconsin, where he excelled academically and athletically at Whitefish Bay High School, lettering in track, football and basketball. He attended Tulane University, on a scholarship, and then returned to Wisconsin where he obtained a law degree from the University of Wisconsin/Madison. He was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity.

Michael had over 30 years of experience in the training industry; and over 15 years of experience in dealing with copyright infringement situations within the industry. He spent over 20 years working for several of the most respected companies in the training industry (Xerox Learning Systems, Learning International, Times Mirror Training / Achieve Global and Huthwaite). He then decided to become an entrepreneur focusing on two areas where he has had the greatest success and most satisfaction. Developing training programs &

providing consulting services to training companies that were losing revenue due to copyright infringement.

The programs that Michael produced have been purchased by thousands of organizations throughout the world and have been used for the training of over 2,000,000 people. The program purchases made by these organizations total over \$600,000,000.00. Purchasers in the U.S. have included over 300 of the Fortune 500 companies.

In 1991 he became director of legal services for Learning International Inc.. In 1995 his role was expanded when he was named international director of intellectual property for Times Mirror Training Inc.. Learning International along with three other Times Mirror owned training companies. He was given the responsibility for protecting all intellectual property assets of the corporation and its divisions. Over the years, Michael has dealt with over 100 possible infringement situations involving competitors, current clients, former clients, non-clients and former employees.

Michael is also survived by his sister Sandra (Duff) Radick-Roman, his nephew John Roman and many aunts, uncles and cousins. He is preceded in death by his parents Louis M. and Zorka R. Radick, nee Gillis.

At his request, a cremation has taken place and a private memorial service will be held at Orange Beach, Alabama.
