Nora Ylagan, nee Dulatre, 71, of Niles, Illinois.

Nora cherished her time as a long-time nurse at St. Anthony Hospital in Chicago's southside where she worked for over 30 years. Nursing was undoubtedly her calling, and she was passionate about caring for not only her patients, but her co-workers, as well. Many colleagues considered her as a "second mother". When they found out about Nora's passing, several offered great stories about Nora to her daughters.

Due to Covid, Nora voluntarily retired in 2020 in order to continue watching her grandchildren, Dylan and Luca. However, she could not accept the end of her career so in 2023, Nora began working for a home health agency and then began to study to renew her license in 2024 so she could return to St. Anthony Hospital.

At the same time, Nora took business and social media classes because she wanted to "keep her mind sharp."

Nora loved to garden. She would often “complain” about how hard it was on her knees, but she spent hours tending to her flowers and fruit and vegetable plants.

She also loved to cook and would reinvent or modify recipes to accommodate allergies or Melissa and Hermen’s vegetarian diet. Even after working 16-hour shifts, she would still cook so that her family had a homemade meal every day.

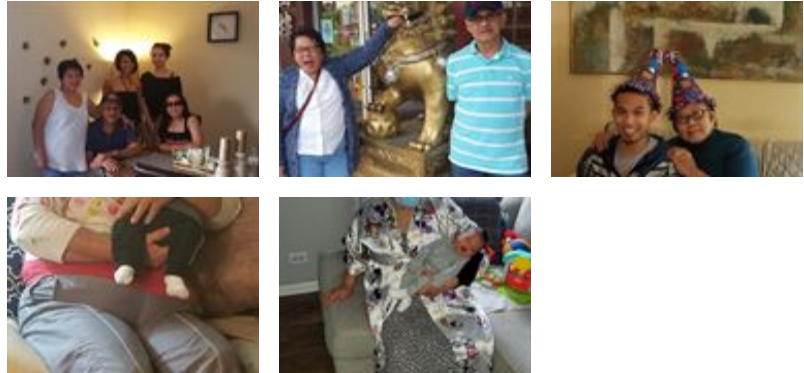
