Mr. Himmelstein then recruited him to launch a new company, S. Himmelstein and Company, where he continued to work for nearly 50 years until his retirement in 2011. He is the holder of several patents that were instrumental in the development of the products still

being manufactured by S. Himmelstein and Company.

Outside of work, he enjoyed his family and working around the house. Anything that needed repairing he always preferred the challenge of trying to fix it himself. In his younger days he enjoyed model airplanes and model railroading. Later Richard and Elizabeth took on Square Dancing, advancing to higher and higher levels of challenge dancing.
