Bob and I, along with other leaders and the scouts from Troop 461, were fortunate to attend Philmont Scout Ranch about 25 years ago. This was a dream I was never able to experience when I was a youth. Both Bob and I trained for months for this event but were still in no shape to keep up with the teenagers.

We were the last two to make it into camp after the first full day of hiking. On the second day we applied something called the "rest-step" technique. This method allowed us to take slower and shorter steps but no rest breaks. When we came to the troop's first rest break, the boys were all rested and ready to go. But Bob and I did not stop, we stayed with the boys. When they took their next break Bob and I did not stop and this time passed them up. Bob and I continued in the same manner all day and finally reached the summit - about 45 minutes ahead of everyone else. I've always remembered our accomplishment. I'll always remember the view from the top.
