His relationship with Christ was the quiet anchor of his soul, providing a steady light even during his darkest hours. This unwavering devotion was not just a belief, but the very foundation upon which he built his resilience and grace. He now rests peacefully and wholly in the presence of his Savior.

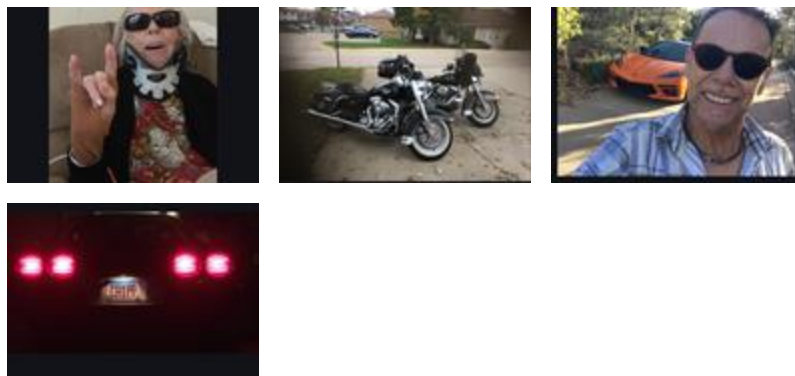
