Thomas Malloy of Chicago, IL, was born on July 28th, 1941 and died at the age of 79 on February 10th, 2021. He is survived by his wife and best friend of 56 years, Sabine. Tom was the loving father of Patty (Todd) Kimble and Michael (Debbie) Malloy. His cherished grandchildren are Jessica (25), Alex (23), Emma (20), Morganne (16), and Cameron (14).

Tom attended Schurz High School, Wright Jr. College (Associate's Degree), Illinois Institute of Technology (Bachelor of Science), and Loyola University where he received his PhD in Organic Chemistry. Upon graduation, he worked at Desoto as a chemist and retired as a Director of Research at UOP, Division of Honeywell. While working at UOP, he was granted 33 patents. After retirement, he became an Adjunct Professor of Organic Chemistry and taught at McHenry County College, Moraine Valley Community College, Harper College, and College of DuPage. He was an active member of the American Chemical Society (ACS). Tom enjoyed investing, going on vacation, and

spending time with his Grandchildren. He had a wonderful sense of humor and a heart of gold.
