He first worked on timeclocks, then typewriters, and finally computers. He worked for IBM for 39 years, many of those taking the train from the suburbs to their office downtown. Walt briefly attended Purdue University, studying engineering. He loved to tinker with things. He was always figuring out ways to make things work better in his home, and he was always the “fix-it” guy, with broken toys and electronics making their way to his home shop for repair and restoration.

Walt very much enjoyed the time spent with his kids doing Indian Princesses and then YUS girls with his daughters and then Cub Scouts with his son. He enjoyed camping and the community of these groups, creating friendships that outlasted the various organizations.

In recent years, Walt made the Oaks of Bartlett his home. He enjoyed meeting new people and spending time getting to know them.
